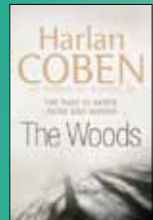




The Waterstones Card guide to *Harlan Coben*

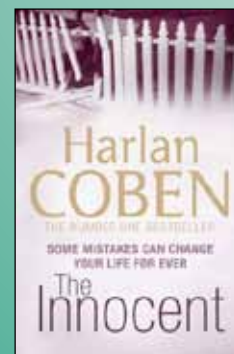
Tell No One
